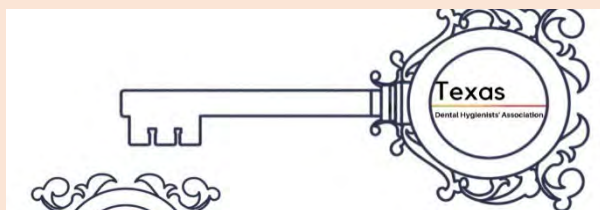

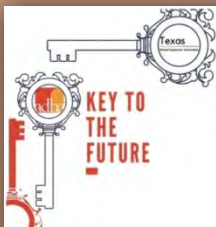

LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

TDHA has been hard at work to represent all dental hygienists and expand practice in the state of Texas! We had two bills submitted to the Texas legislature in general legislative session where one of them (HB2056) regarding Teledentistry was passed into law in June. TDHA submitted testimony at the stakeholder meeting in August to the Texas State Board of Dental Examiners as rules for this new legislation was being proposed. This legislation and new rule allow a dentist to delegate and supervise no more than five health professionals, including dental hygienists, through a Teledentistry service with the patient's informed consent. This means a dental hygienist practicing Teledentistry dental hygiene services as defined in Texas Occupations Code §111.001(2-a) is practicing in an alternate setting (including a nursing home, the patient's home, a school, a hospital, a state institution, a public health clinic or another institution, under the supervision of a supervising dentist). We look forward to improving access to care to underserved populations as well with the passage of SB 1648 regarding Medicaid benefits for disabled adults on the STAR+PLUS Medicaid program to receive one preventative dental visit per year. We are looking ahead to continue momentum and submit a bill to expand Texas dental hygienist scope of practice to include administering local anesthesia in the next regular Texas legislative session in 2023.

We are preparing for the next legislative session as it is never too early to nurture the existing relationships and create new ones with legislators, dentists, and other healthcare professionals. TDHA recognized Representative Stephanie Klick and Senator Charles Perry as TDHA Legislative Champions for the 2021 legislative session. We appreciate their cooperation to move our profession forward and supporting our efforts to promote oral health in all communities and populations of Texas. A few easy actions to connect with legislators are to look up who your local legislators are and like their social media pages. Introducing yourself as the legislator's constituent, that you are a dental hygienist, and are happy to be a resource for them is a way to start building a relationship. Legislators represent you as their constituent! If you have questions of how to do this, please reach out and we can help you. I am happy to speak to anyone about legislative efforts and how to become involved. Thank you all for what you do for our association and profession!

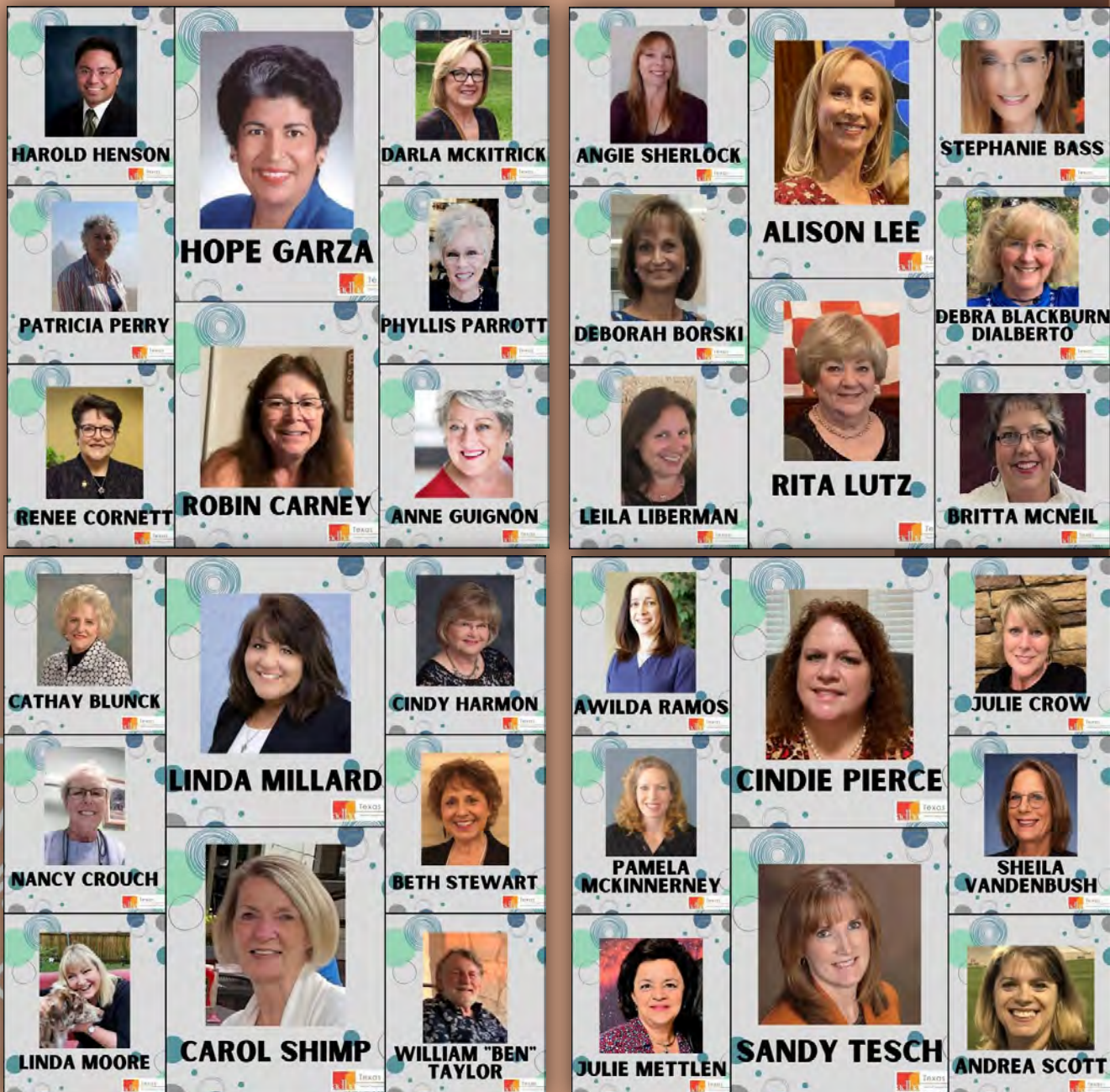

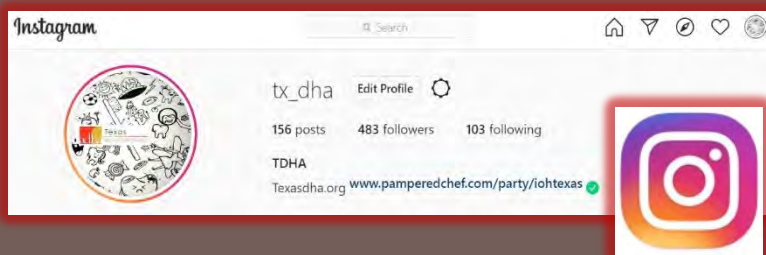
